Be thou my God.

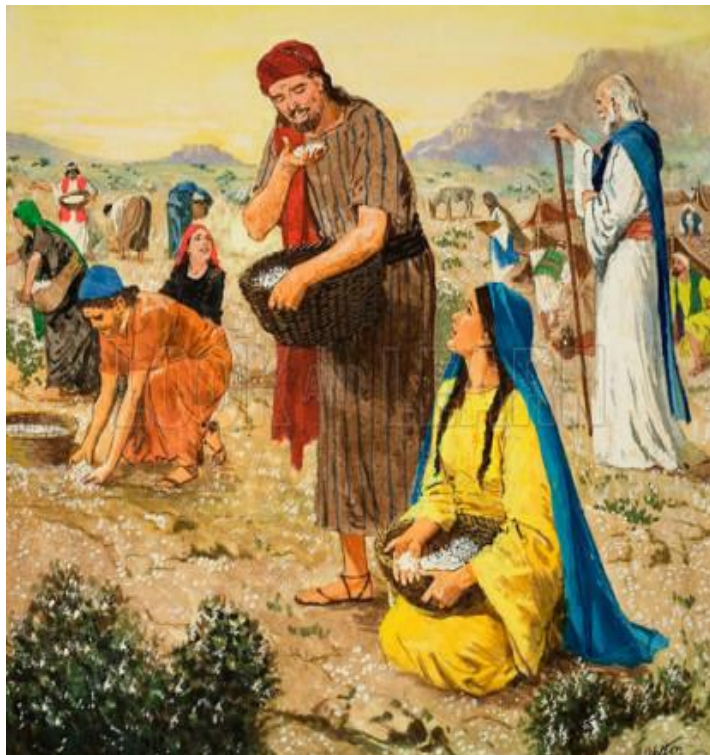
Thou, thou, the Ideal Man,
