Loveliest of Trees by A. E Housman

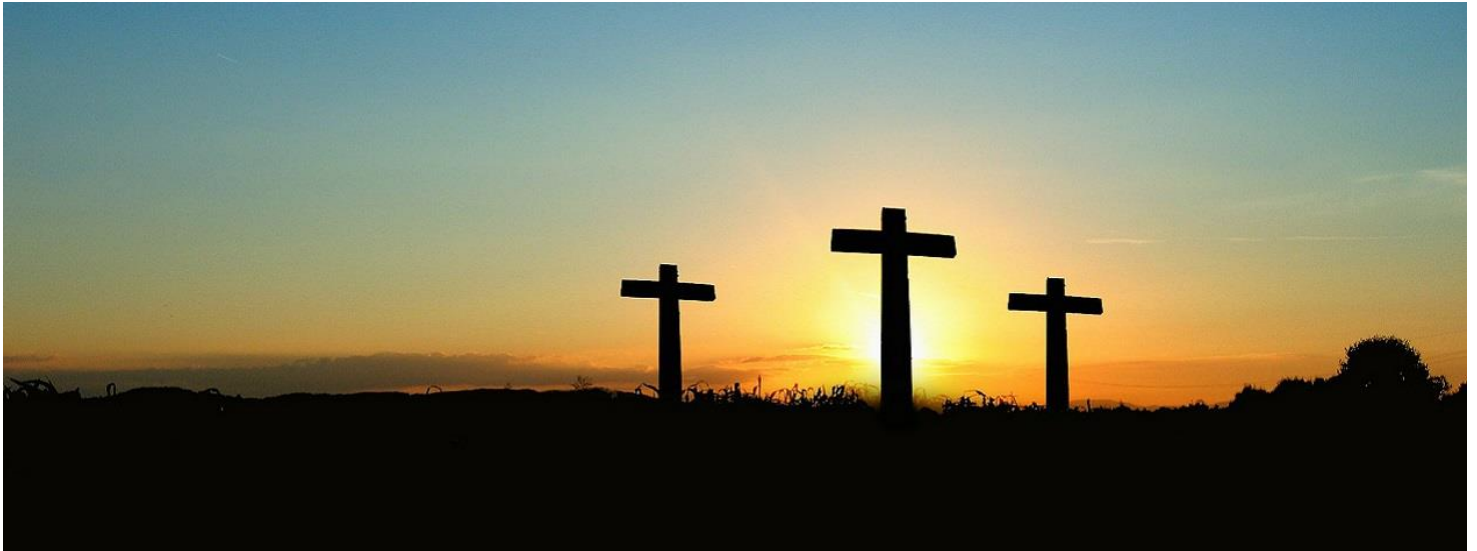
Loveliest of trees, the cherry now
